The Asian College of Neuropsychopharmacology (AsCNP) 7th Virtual Congress 2021 will be taking place from 08:30AM to 5:30PM over two days on 22 October (Friday) and 23 October (Saturday). Each session will comprise plenary talks and two parallel symposia covering a broad range of topics pertaining to neuropsychopharmacology.

We are soliciting abstract submissions for potential symposiums sessions, oral and poster presentations for this conference. Posters will be presented in virtual formats on our social media platform. All abstracts will be reviewed by the scientific advisory committee of the scientific meeting and all decisions made will be final

Your abstract should align with or fall under one of the following broad topics:

Symposium Description

- A symposium is a 90 minute session with a theme on a specific scientific or clinically relevant topic related to neuropsychopharmacology.
- There are 3-4 speakers per symposium, limited to 20-25 minutes per speaker, with 5 minutes for Q&A with the audience at the end of each presentation.
- We support gender, age and career development equality and equity. Please, ensure that your speakers represent a diversity of genders, ages, and career stages. Geographic diversity of speakers within each symposium is also encouraged but be cognizant of the time zone differences for speakers at the virtual conference.

Oral Session Description

- Each oral session is a 10 minute slide presentation with an additional 5min Q&A on a specific scientific or clinically relevant topic related to neuropsychopharmacology.

Poster Session Description

- A poster session showcases your research and allows viewers to discuss it with you.
- Posters will be displayed during lunch break (1230-1330) on each day.
- Presenters are encouraged to standby during the poster session to answer any questions from the viewers.

Guidelines for Submission and Presentation

All abstracts must be submitted using the ONLINE ABSTRACT SUBMISSION FORM by 5 pm 31 May 2021. Only abstracts submitted via the online form will be accepted.

Abstracts must be written in English.

The abstract text is limited to 250 words (1,750 characters). The abstract title, the author(s) and names of institutions are not included in the count of 250 words.

References are optional. An abbreviated form is acceptable, for instance Chua ZY et al. *Journal of Psychiatry*. 2020;82:100–110.

Please, do not include tables, graphs or images in the abstract.

Abstracts may be revised and resubmitted before the deadline of 5 pm 31 May 2021.
